CONFESSION AND ABSOLUTION

- L: Hosanna! Hosanna in the highest!
- C: Blessed is He who comes in the name of the Lord. Hosanna to the Son of David.
- L: On this day when we remember Jesus' entry into Jerusalem as King and Savior, we join with the inhabitants of Jerusalem, with loud shouts of hosanna and praise. The King is coming and we celebrate. But we also inwardly examine ourselves. As we come before the throne of our King, we pray that God would search our hearts and minds that we may receive His Word, share in His Spirit, and be renewed in our relationships with Him and with one another.

We take a moment of silence for personal prayers of confession.

- L: Lord Jesus, the King of kings and Lord of lords, hear us as we pray:
- C: Lord, You reign over all things and yet humbled Yourself for our salvation. We confess that our rebellion against You in thought, word, and deed is the reason why You entered into this world. It is why You passed through the gates of Jerusalem on Palm Sunday and why You laid down Your life upon Calvary's cross on Good Friday—to forgive our sins, to redeem our lives, and to cancel the debt we owe to God. With hearts that are humble and lives that are grateful, help us to receive Your grace and bow before You in worship. Amen.
- L: Almighty God, our heavenly Father, shows His mercy to us in the sending of His only Son, the King of kings and Lord of lords. The One who entered into Jerusalem on Palm Sunday was handed over to death upon the cross so that we may be reconciled to the Father and granted His remission, full and free. In Him is forgiveness of sins, life, and salvation. As a called and ordained servant of Christ, I therefore forgive you all your sins in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit.

C: Amen.

²⁸ And when he had said these things, he went on ahead, going up to Jerusalem. ²⁹ When he drew near to Bethphage and Bethany, at the mount that is called Olivet, he sent two of the disciples, 30 saying, "Go into the village in front of you, where on entering you will find a colt tied, on which no one has ever yet sat. Untie it and bring it here. 31 If anyone asks you, 'Why are you untying it?' you shall say this: 'The Lord has need of it.'" 32 So those who were sent went away and found it just as he had told them. 33 And as they were untying the colt, its owners said to them, "Why are you untying the colt?" 34 And they said, "The Lord has need of it." 35 And they brought it to Jesus, and throwing their cloaks on the colt, they set Jesus on it. 36 And as he rode along, they spread their cloaks on the road. 37 As he was drawing near—already on the way down the Mount of Olives—the whole multitude of his disciples began to rejoice and praise God with a loud voice for all the mighty works that they had seen, 38 saying, "Blessed is the King who comes in the name of the Lord! Peace in heaven and glory in the highest!" 39 And some of the Pharisees in the crowd said to him, "Teacher, rebuke your disciples." 40 He answered, "I tell you, if these were silent, the very stones would cry out." (ESV)
